Youth Protection Training

All Adults and Scouts Leaders attending any portion of our Troop outings and activities are required to complete the Youth Protection Training (YPT) every **two years**. To make this easier on the Troop, if possible, please retake the training at this time.

If your Youth Protection Training is not current, please complete the free 20 minute training video located at the link below.

Before you can take the training, you need an account on my.scouting.org.

- You already have an account if you have previously taken the YPT.
- If you are not a registered Adult in Troop 61, you can still create an account on my.scouting.org and complete the training. They will issue you a Temporary Member ID. Register with Three Harbors Council, Troop 61.
- If you do not remember your Member ID, send an email to Brian.moscicki@gmail.com and he will send your Member ID.

The training requires you to watch brief videos each followed by a set of questions.
